

Supplier Code of Conduct

Introduction:

The following Supplier Code of Conduct outlines the standards and expectations that suppliers must adhere to when conducting business with Bracco. This code is designed to ensure compliance with ethical practices, promote safe working conditions, and foster fair treatment of employees. Suppliers are expected to fully understand and comply with the provisions outlined below.

Labor Practices and Standards:

 environmental standards, encouraging responsible sourcing and procurement practices, and
 minimizing the environmental impact associated with transportation and logistics activities.
- Environmental Compliance: Suppliers must comply with all applicable environmental laws, regulations, and industry standards in the countries where they operate.
